## LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

# The Middlesbrough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order [2022]

Made 28 September 2022 Coming into force in

accordance with article 1(2)

Middlesbrough Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 7 September 2022:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4), 98(6) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act. of the 2007 Act.

#### Citation and commencement

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Middlesbrough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2022.
  - (2) Subject to paragraphs (3) and (4) below, for administrative and finance purposes this Order comes into force on 1st April 2023.
  - (3) Article 4 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2023.
  - (4) For the purposes of:
    - (a) this article,
    - (b) proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of parish councillors for the parish of Nunthorpe, to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2023, this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which the order was made.

#### Interpretation

2. In this Order

"borough" means the borough of Middlesbrough Council;

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the Middlesbrough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2022" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

"ordinary day of election of councillors" has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

#### Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

#### Number of parish councillors for the parish of Nunthorpe

4. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Nunthorpe shall be 7 (seven)

#### Alteration of parish areas

- 5. The Nunthorpe Parish Council boundary is amended to be coterminous with the Nunthorpe electoral ward boundary.
- 6. Further, the area coloured in **blue** on the map and specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 shall cease to be an unparished area and shall become part of the parish specified in relation to that area in column 4 of the Schedule.
- 7. In addition, and subject to the approval of the Local Government Boundary Commission the areas identified in red on the map will move from the electoral ward of Marton East to the electoral ward of Nunthorpe. The Parish Council Boundary will also be coterminous with the newly proposed Nunthorpe electoral Ward Boundary and include the areas identified in the map (in red) which includes 12-16 Milan Grove and the location currently shown as the Brethren's Meeting Rooms.

#### Electoral register

8. The registration officer for the borough shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

#### Order date

9. 1st April 2023 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Middlesbrough Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Nunthorpe within the borough of Middlesbrough Council.

The parish of Nunthorpe will be altered with effect from 1 April 2023. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2023.

Article provides for parish elections in the parish of Nunthorpe in 2023, and then to continue according to the established system of parish elections every four years.

Article 3 specifies the numbers of parish councillors for the parish of Nunthorpe.

Article 9 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.

The map defined in article 2 shows the new area of the parish of Nunthorpe. It is available, at all reasonable times, at the offices of Middlesbrough Council.
