Dear Sir/Madam,

Frensham Parish Council welcome the fact you have given us the opportunity to comment on the Waverley Borough Council Boundary Review.

As Chairman of Frensham Parish Council I am writing to represent Frensham Parish Council in relation to any potential changes that may impact our Parish Council. We believe the current ward suits its residents well and, ideally, would wish there to be no change. However, given that you are planning to reduce the size of the council to 50, and that you are predicting an increase in Waverley's population of approximately 10% by 2027, we recognise that there are likely to be changes in the future.

For many years we have been working closely in partnership with other rural villages in Surrey that are similar to our own. These villages are collectively called the Western Villages and are made up of Frensham, Dockenfield, Tilford, Churt, Elstead, Brook and Thursley. Although each village is distinct in character, they all share many common characteristics as well as similar challenges and this means working together is natural and straightforward and can result in positive outcomes for all our residents. We feel there is a relatively simple solution and that is to create a ward out of these 7 villages.

We hope you will see your way to proposing a ward consisting of the current villages/electoral registers of Frensham, Dockenfield, Tilford, Churt, Elstead, Brook and Thursley.
