Comment text:

Witley Parish is currently represented by six borough councillors. In the north of the parish, Milford and Eton are represented by two borough councillors in the Milford Ward. These borough councillors represent only that area. In the centre of the Parish, two borough councillors represent Witley and Wormley in the Witley and Hambledon Ward. These two borough councillors also represent the village of Hambledon. In the south of the Parish, two borough councillors represent Brook, Sandhills and parts of Grayswood in the Elstead and Thursley Ward. These two borough councillors also represent the villages of Elstead and Thursley. Geographically, the residential areas of the Parish are largely to the south of the A3 trunk road, along the two major roads that run through the Parish, the A286 and the A283. There is little gap between the built-up areas of Milford and Witley. There are, however, significant splits between Milford and Elstead, and between Witley and Hambledon. As parish councillors, we consider our parish to be one area. Although our thirteen parish councillors represent different wards within the parish, all councillors represent all residents throughout the parish. Issues that affect a particular area rarely stop at the ward boundary. From the borough councillors' perspective, we know that having to support two parishes can be challenging when meetings and events clash. They are also having to liaise with two sets of clerks and parish councillors. Our proposal is therefore to allocate three borough councillors to the whole of Witley Parish. These three could work efficiently together to serve the Parish as a whole, for the benefit of all our residents.
