## PROPOSED WARD BOUNDARY CHANGES

Although Naunton Beauchamp is not directly affected by the proposed Ward Boundary Changes we would like to add our support to our neighbouring villages in opposing the proposed changes.

Naunton Beauchamp is a small rural village with only a church, no village hall, no shop and no public transport so we do rely on our neighbouring rural villages for support. For example :-

Villagers use the shop at Upton Snodsbury and Peopleton

Naunton Beauchamp WI meet in Upton Snodsbury village hall

Children from the village go to either Upton Snodsbury First School or Flyford Flavell Primary School.

We feel that the Upton Snodsbury Ward is very aware of our rural needs and shares a similar outlook. Any alignment with much larger and growing settlements will mean that their very size will dominate and swamp the agenda, with housing, social care, highways and other community needs.

We therefore ask the Commission to consider carefully the needs and future of villages and small rural communities similar to us such as Peopleton and Kington and Dormston and keep them together in the Upton Snodsbury Ward.
