Currently there are:

- 126 councillors
- 63 divisions
- II single-councillor divisions,
 - 41 two-councillor divisions,
 - II three-councillor divisions

A public consultation is open until **10 July 2023**



We aim to make sure County

Durham councillors represent a

similar number of electors




Currently there are:

- 15 divisions that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- I division that is more than30% away from the average

We are proposing:

- 98 councillors
- 48 divisions
- nine single-councillor divisions, 28 two-councillor divisions and 11 threecouncillor divisions



Our proposals mean that:

- No divisions will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- Each councillor will represent an average of 4,150 electors
