NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 126 councillors
- 63 divisions
- 11 single-councillor divisions,
41 two-councillor divisions,
11 three-councillor divisions

We are proposing:

- 98 councillors
- 48 divisions
- nine single-councillor
divisions, 28 two-councillor
divisions and 11 three-
councillor divisions

A public consultation is open until
10 July 2023



We aim to make sure County
Durham councillors represent a
similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 15 divisions that are more
than 10% away from the
average number of electors
per division
- 1 division that is more than
30% away from the average

Our proposals mean that:

- No divisions will be more
than 10% away from the
average number of electors
per division
- Each councillor will represent
an average of 4,150 electors
