Something really simple based on larger areas of the county would surely be sensible. Dividing them up in roughly equal sized areas. Then divide them further to make it more manageable. Centred on Durham City (larger area that includes what most people would class as Durham City, from say Framwellgate to Gilesgate) Then north Durham for North of this, West Durham for West of this south and east. Then lets take East Durham as an example. East Durham, North - Seaham and Murton, cut off Say being Cold Heselden. East Durham East - Peterlee to Cold Heselden, inc Easington, Horden, Shotton, Haswell. East Durham, West - Trimdons, Thornley, Sherburn East Durham, South - Blackhalls, Wingate. Some redrawing of boundries for example maybe the edge of the Sedgefield area from say fishburn doen the the county border could be merged with East Durham, South. There is no need to have such complicated divisions on the map, square / round some areas off and just divide up areas a bit more sensibly. Allocate councillors based on population in the areas in which they stand, so the councillor(s) for Weardale will have a greater area to cover, but with less people in the area I would hope it would balance out the councillor(s) for Durham City would have a smaller area to cover but with many more people. I would be willing to go into more detail / work this out fully, with someone sensible, in person if so desired.
