### Comment text:

Ellesmere Urban's boundaries should be extended outwards to encompass e.g. the industrial estate and the marina, as they employ people in the town. It is common sense that a resident of a town who also works in the industrial estate should be represented by the same councillor. The Meres division is perhaps too large. Its western fringe residents would look towards Oswestry, and may have different needs when compared with e.g. the wealthy, Shrewsbury facing Harmer Hill. Harmer Hill probably has more in common with Baschurch in terms of their close ties to the county town. Welshampton, currently in the Meres division, has many pupils who travel in from Ellesmere, and perhaps closer ties between the two settlements could be explored. Alternatively, the eastern part of the St Martin's ward could be merged with the northern half of the current Meres division, as these areas share similarities in terms of their residents use of services in Ellesmere, as well as their cross-border interactions with Wales.
