Comment text:

The division of the Ludlow area into the two parishes of Ludlow and Ludford causes significant problems in that Ludford relies entirely on Ludlow for all its amenities, but Ludford rate payers pay considerably less than Ludlow ones, who are being unfairly penalised. Also the division of planning controls between the two councils means that decisions made by Ludford Council have a disproportionate effect on Ludlow Town because of the growth of both residential and commercial developments along the A49, which have a significant impact on the town. The part of Ludlow South north of the River Teme should be transferred to Ludlow East and moved into Ludlow Parish.
