Dear Sir / Madam,

I am writing in my capacity as Chair of Governors at Fulmer Infant School in Buckinghamshire to express concern about the proposed changes to ward boundaries detailed within your current consultation to Buckinghamshire residents.

The changes to the four ward boundaries include a change which would see Fulmer Village in a different ward from Gerrards Cross going forwards.

There are close links between the schools in the villages south of Gerrards Cross and those to the north in Gerrards Cross and Chalfont St Peter. Many of the children who attend Fulmer Infant School move at the end of Year 2 to Chalfont St Peter Academy or to the Gerrards Cross School. We work hard as a school to develop and maintain links not only between the schools but also between the communities to ensure that this transition is positive. Any structure that links these communities geographically or socially is helpful to us – and to those supporting from a village, council or school perspective – to understand any issues families may be facing.

I am therefore concerned that the proposal is for Fulmer and Gerrards Cross / Chalfont St Peter to be in separate wards and believe this is not in the communities best interests. I would like this concern to be included within the consultation responses for consideration.
