## NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS


## **Currently there are:**

- 48 councillors
- 20 wards
- ten three-councillor wards, eight two-councillor wards and two one-councillor wards

292 residents and organisations helped shape our recommendations

## From elections in 2024:

- 39 councillors
- 14 wards
- twelve three-councillor wards, one two-councillor ward and one one-councillor ward



We aim to make sure Tunbridge Wells councillors represent a similar number of electors

# ΩŢΛ

## **Currently there are:**

- Four wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 2,186 electors

## Tunbridge Wells will move towards:

- Three wards being more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 2,334 electors
