Comment text:

The current ward boundaries are failing the people of south east Staffordshire by having too much land area in one ward and not correctly aligning the wards with the current population, demographic and issues with larger towns. A prime example of this is Tamworth which has seen rapid population growth and needs a greater representation and better alignment of neighbouring towns and villages which use its services. For example, I strongly believe that the Lichfield Rural East Ward needs to be split to better align with the demographics of the area. Fazeley, Drayton Bassett and Mile Oak have seen significant increases in population and should no longer be paired with large areas of countryside which have completely different needs and issues. This area needs to be given its own representation or merged with another ward that better aligns to the demographic and issues within this area.
