Re: Surrey County Council Boundary Commission Review

I am writing on behalf of Brockham Parish Council (BPC) who considered the above consultation at their Council meeting on Monday 20 May 2023

Brockham Parish Council, has reviewed the LGBCE MVDC wards of Surrey County Council and comment on that part of the consultation.

We request that Brockham, Betchworth and Buckland remain allocated to one division because this would ensure we are all focused on rural parishes,

We also ask that consideration is given to including the newly formed Mole Valley District Ward of Brockham, Betchworth, Box Hill, Buckland and Headley (comprising of the former two MVDC Councillor ward and one Councillor ward of Box Hill and Headley)

These requests would ensure there is a consistency of potential synergies between the five communities to be heightened.

Brockham Parish Council ask the Boundary Commission to give significant weight to its request not to create divisions which combine rural communities in the south of Mole Valley with the market towns of Dorking and Leatherhead or the more suburban communities to north of Dorking.
