NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 63 councillors
- 61 divisons
- 59 single-councillor divisions and one two-councillor divison

A public consultation is open until II December 2023

We aim to make sure Oxfordshire councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 21 divisions that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- 2 divisions that are more than 30% away from the average

We are proposing:

- 69 councillors
- 69 divisions
- I councillor per division



Our proposals mean that:

- 5 divisions will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 8449 electors
