NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

October 2023

Currently there are:

- 78 councillors
- 26 wards
- 3 councillors per ward

163 comments from residents and organisations helped shape our recommendations

We aim to make sure North Northamptonshire councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- Two wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- No wards that are more than 30% away from the average

From elections in 2025:

- 68 councillors
- 31 wards
- 12 three-member wards, 13 two-

member wards, 6 one-member wards



North Northamptonshire will move towards:

- One ward being more than
 10% away from the average
 number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 4,211 electors
