Along with all residents with whom I have spoken in Tatsfield village and surrounds, I firmly believe this entire area of special interest and need would be severely disadvantaged by the proposed merger with Limpsfield ward.

No advantage whatsoever has been suggested for the change.

Yet many disadvantages have been made very clear by the local Parish Council, our local Councillor and local residents. Alarmingly, it seems at the moment as though all those views are being over-run as an attempt is made to steamroller through the change.

The unique nature and location of the village mean that it has very special, localised issues and requirements. There is no way that a ward combined with Limpsfield could cater for those needs.

There are already issues of public transport connectivity and minor anti social behavioural issues which feature amongst the plethora of other needs in the village and which would without doubt be subsumed or ignored in favour of the more populated Limpsfield. The louder voices (because there are more of them) will always be heard first.

There is therefore no doubt at all that the proposed merging of these wards is fundamentally detrimental to Tatsfield & Titsey. If it is allowed to continue it would be a very clear signal to all who live there that they are of no importance at all to the local area, and their needs will in future be

relegated to the bottom of a pile comprised largely of issues within Limpsfield.
