Dear Sir

I am against the proposal to amalgamate Tatsfield and Limpsfield under the proposed changes in electoral and boundary arrangements. Tatsfield is unique in many of the issues we face and a very different area to Limpsfield.

Tatsfield borders both Kent and the London bough of Bromley. We have a kent postal address, pay our local taxes to Surrey and have medical services (GP, hospitals, and dentists etc based in Bromley). Many of the issues we face are as a result of these divisions in responsibilities for issues such as road maintenance and access to services etc.

Tatsfield is a small village with little public transport and quickly becomes isolated in periods of bad weather due to its altitude and small country lanes, where as Limpsfield is in the valley, merges into Oxted and has access to busses, a station and is close to the A25.

We only have a small village shop and a post office. Limpsfield is within walking distance of all the shops and facilities of Oxted town centre. Many of the issues we face can only be understood fully by a council representative who lives in the village and experiences for themselves the impact these issues have on our daily lives. I therefore think we need to continue with our own representative and not be bundled up with Limpsfield.
