.Tatsfield is a rural community situated atop the north downs and bounded by the greater London area and the county of Kent. We differ considerably from Limpsfield which has a significantly higher population and higher density housing. To date the needs of Tatsfield have been more than adequately met by a single District Councillor, resident in the village, who is very familiar with the needs of the community. There is a real danger that amalgamation with Limpsfield will lead to the loss of our local representative as Limpsfield, due to their much higher voting population could, and undoubtedly would, monopolise all three seats. Tatsfield is unique in this part of Surrey and has enjoyed strong representation on Tandridge District Council from Councillors of varying political persuasion over the 47 years I have lived here. To lose that representation would be a disaster for the village. I note that the significantly wealthier area of Woldingham, with a roughly similar electoral population will be allowed to retain their sole District Councillor. Is this a case of money talks and we are the poor relations?
