**Related subject:** Tatsfield

Tatsfield is a very special village. A rural community at the top of the Surrey/Kent hills. While part of Surrey, Tatsfield is geographically separate from the other communities that make up the Tandridge ward. Indeed Tatsfield, is also closely linked with Biggin Hill, and residents divide their use of many services (eg education and shopping) and amenities between Oxted and Biggin Hill. Postcode wise we are unable to register for use of GP services in Oxted. The weather in winter from snow to fog can also isolate Tatsfield and present village-specific issues. The concerns and needs of Tatsfield residents are therefore distinctly different from those of Limpsfield. Whilst Limpsfield is a village, it is so more culturally than geographically and its needs very different. It is therefore imperative that Tatsfield retains its one-ward status. In addition, I would question why Woldingham which is in the same position should be considered worthy of one-ward status when Tatsfield is not.
