I am struggling to understand the logic of putting Stafford Road into Queens Park. The former sits in Caterham Valley and is very much in a Valley. Moving it into a Caterham-on-the-hill area seems illogical. While I appreciate there are roads either end enabling access to the Hill area, there are several retirement blocks of flats in Stafford Road the residents of which are less likely to be travelling up a hill on a regular basis and therefore are less likely to have affinity with the Queens Park ward.
