I strongly object to the concentration of the large variances from average in the north west of the District, particularly Caterham and Whyteleafe. This area contains most of the deprived parts of the district and the highest density of population.

Caterham and Whyteleafe is already poorly served and the proposed changes make the situation worse.

The rural south of the district already has a disproportionate influence on the Council, and Caterham and Whyteleafe are historically disadvantaged compared to the south.

More effort should be made to at least balance out the variances from average, and it would in fact be fairer if the north of the district had LOW variance from averages and the south equal or HIGHER variances.

This is especially important as the population in the southern areas tend to be more vocal, more likely to be engaged and thus more likely to exert influence on the Council. This needs to be balanced by ensuring representation is fair and equal throughout the district
