Caterham is quite distinctly split between Valley and Hill. The geography leaves no doubt as to the names. Stafford Road has no logical political representation relationship in common to "Queens Park" on the Hill, despite your dubious efforts to suggest otherwise. The communities are quite distinct. I'd recommend that you walk the streets and experience the change in elevation before making such assumptions. The Valley should retain it's identity (you seem to accept this for Woldingham with just one representative). It would better reflect the local community to retain two x two representative Wards than force a paper change to tick boxes here. You persist with using the name Westway (now proposed with Chaldon) for a Ward when the actual road/common land so named sits entirely within Queens Park per the proposals. As I understand the remit is also to name the Wards in relation to the area they represent, as a resident, I have always considered this quite the misnomer.
