**Related subject:** Location of Hove Edge, Brighouse - boundaries between Brighouse and Hipperholme & Lightcliffe Wards.

I live in the community of Hove Edge, Brighouse. The Ward boundaries of Brighouse and Hipperholme & Lightcliffe cut Hove Edge in half. Hove Edge has 3 local eateries, 2 pubs, 2 primary schools, a secondary school and a small recreation ground all serving the Hove Edge area and most being within the Hipperholme & Lightcliffe Ward.

I think Hove Edge should be within the Brighouse Ward. Hove Edge is Brighouse - not Hipperholme or Lightcliffe areas. The Ward boundary between Brighouse and Hipperholme & Lightcliffe should follow the post code areas. Post code HD6 and phone std code 01484 serve Brighouse whereas Hipperholme and Lightcliffe have the Halifax HX3 post code and phone std cod 01422. The post code sectors/areas make sense for the Ward boundaries recognising localities. There is a natural boundary between the 2 Wards, the area of "Broad Oak", which separates Hipperholme and Hove Edge.

Whilst I live in the Brighouse Ward, most issues affecting me fall in Hipperholme & Lightcliffe Ward - planning applications, community safety and other local issues Ward Forums & PACT meetings - all come under the remit of Hipperholme & Lightcliffe Ward Councillors, not my Brighouse Councillors.

Please consider moving the boundary between the two Wards north towards Broad Oak where the post codes change between one area and the other.
