In line with extensive questionnaire responses from our supporters, we support any proposal that retains and protects the integrity of Worfield as a parish as it is. Whilst we can see the logic of amending the division to include Claverly for election of county councillors, we worry that this will also 'water down' the influence of the voice of Worfield Parish residents, and WPC, at Shropshire Council. In particular, we share residents ongoing concerns that landowners aggressively seeking to develop land in Worfield Parish have brought to bear undue influence on County Councillors and under these new proposals we will not have a county councillor to solely represent our interests. We would ask that you think very carefully before changing the boundaries of the division, that electoral equality is not just considered from the point of view of population numbers, but also in terms of the distinct 'voice' of the residents and our elected representative's ability to represent us properly.
