NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 126 councillors
- 63 divisions
- 11 three-councillor divisions, 41 two-councillor divisions, 11 single-councillor divisions

From elections in 2025:

- 98 councillors
- 51 divisions
- Nine three-councillor divisions, 29 two-councillor divisions and 13 single-councillor divisions

371 residents and organisations
helped shape our recommendations



We aim to make sure County
Durham councillors represent a
similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 18 divisions that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- Four divisions that are more than 30% away from the average

County Durham will move towards:

- One division being more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- Each councillor representing an average of 4,150 electors
