The current boundary review is not considering the views of local communities. Living in Burley In Wharfedale it's felt that the council see this area as a cash cow with little if any investment. For example Ilkley has/is a social hot spot but CCTV was refused by the council yet introduced many many parking charges and effectively deterring footfall and access to green spaces (charges at the lido and sports fields). Currently a 20 mph is being imposed when it's not needed. The data on accidents shows that's it would not improve anything only make it noisier for residents and uncomfortable to drive within the area. Burley In Wharfedale only sees any advancement through the parish council, with Bradford council removing funding on many projects eg Library.

Therefore the boundary commission should look at creating a new/ merged structure to cater for local needs... as per the recommendations of MPs Phillip David and Robbie Moore
