**Related subject:** Croome Ward within Worcestershire County Council

Having looked at the current electorate and the proposed Electorate for 2029, which I believe may be higher than expected (see below), i believe that there should be no change to the current Wards of Croome and also Powick. I am not qualified to comment on other wards within the Boundary Review. From the first proposed change to include some of the properties EAST of the River Severn to go to Powick from Croome ward would have been just a logistical nightmare.

My reason for believing that the numbers expected are higher than what I expect is because the local developers are building and submitting planning applications but not at the level that you believe. The numbers are better after the amendment of the figures, but I cannot see Kempsey (Croome Ward) increasing by a population of 1283 which equates to 855 extra property growth (average 1.5 adults per property) even though expansion in Upton, Ripple and Kempsey is proposed. The local development plan will not "kick-in" for at least 5 to 7 years and then not on the scale predicted. I can see growth in 2033 to 2038 but that is a long way ahead of your planned period of 2029. Thank you for allowing me to comment.
