I believe the St John Division is in its current size and boundaries, is a perfect example of community. It has a strong community identity and represents the historic and natural boundaries of the former village of St John's. However, I would make one suggestion for change, polling district K4A should be moved from its current Bedwardine Division and into St John. This is the only part of the former village of St John's which is outside the boundary of the Division, the residents who live there have a natural affinity to St John's and often question why they are in Bedwardine Division. Indeed, the Church of St John's, which is the oldest church in continuous use in Worcester, is in this polling district, not in the Division which carries its name. It's also included within the City Council Ward of St John's, which creates confusion for residents when they are told they are in Bedwardine, which is a place many have never heard of.
