Currently there are:

- 60 councillors
- 20 wards
- 3 councillors per ward

A public consultation is open until 8 April 2024



We aim to make sure Walsall councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 5 wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- 0 wards that is more than
 30% away from the average

We are proposing:

- 60 councillors
- 20 wards
- 3 councillors per ward



Our proposals mean that:

- I ward will be more than
 10% away from the average
 number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 3,750 electors
