Related subject: Severn Stoke and Croome d'Abitot Parish, Croome division

This is the second representation made by this parish council, necessitated because Parish Councillors understand that in relation to the Croome Division there has been some confusion/errors with regard to projected electorate numbers up to 2029. I wish to confirm that the 'current' electorate for Croome Division in 2022 is 7845 and the projected electorate in 2029 is 9128. This is within the accepted tolerance/variance of +/- 10% change. This shows that there is no need for a change of the boundaries in the division encompassing Severn Stoke and Croome d'Abitot. Parish Councillors request and advocate a retention of the status quo in ward/division boundaries. At this present time, our county councillor is able to dedicate time and attention to Severn Stoke and Croome and has played a significant role in the parish achieving critical flood protection (bund to be constructed late 2023 to 2026) - a reorganisation of boundaries would risk our parish being 'lost' in terms of county councillor time and commitment.
