As a resident of Netherton for the majority of my 50+ years I still have no idea why our village is lumped in a ward with Crosland Moor and Thornton Lodge. For public transport, shops, places of worship, social events, leisure activities, doctors, schools, economically, amongst many other factors, I would say that Honley and Meltham are our most suitable match. Personally I have no connection with Crosland Moor or Thornton Lodge other than an occasional need to drive through to get somewhere else. Our Infant & Nursery School is linked to Honley High School, and most of the students from the Junior school opt to study there. We have patients registered at Honley Surgery, we use the restaurants in Honley and Meltham, the supermarkets at Meltham. The bus services link us with Meltham, and the border with Honley is much nearer to the majority of Netherton residents than CM or TL. You can see on the maps that Netherton is an awkward lump stuck on the bottom of the Ward and would be better streamlined into the Holme Valley North Ward.
