Dear Sir/Madam,

I write with reference to your ongoing periodic review of the division boundaries for Oxfordshire County Council.

A city councillor working group was set to consider the review insofar as Oxford was concerned and to make recommendations to Council as it saw fit. It is made up of five councillors: three Labour, one Liberal Democrat and one Green.

Due to the timing of this initial consultation period (during elections and across Easter and Mayday) it was not possible for the whole working group to meet, discuss the options and agree a position to report to Council.

However, three of the five members of the group have expressed support for the County Council's draft scheme as submitted to the Commission, amended to move polling district CA from the proposed Summertown division into the Wolvercote division. As a result of that proposal the splits proposed by the County for the existing polling district DB are not required.

As the working group have yet to have a full formal meeting, I write as the Leader of the Council to say that this view is provisional and will be confirmed or adjusted at the next stage, when the working group will have more time to meet and discuss the Commission's draft scheme.
