I now realise why North Leigh is not properly represented being new to the area. I have complained that cyclists and pedestrians have no footpath or Street lighting on the A4095 between common road and Park Road a really bad section for commuting cyclists and pedestrians . Generally street lighting is very poor in Common Road especially the A4095 junction on a bend not lit either (I presume the Council removed the tree where someone died recently coming from Witney. Its even worse coming from Long Hanborough turning into Common Road at night spotting the turn when its unlit. Hanborough looks well represented but North Leigh seems not properly serviced (Utilities) or represented . The speed limit reduction from 50mph was refused at this point even though new housing has gone ahead everything at this junction was obviously at contractors expense even putting LED cats eyes in the road that disappear also towards Common Road Junction. The next road death will either be a cyclist or pedestrian willing to venture navigating between Common Road and Park Road on the A4095 where they are removing trees currently simply for resources or timber costs ? Can someone provide a boundary that will make it safe for road users pedestrians cyclists. I guess its all safe around the Council Offices at Woodgreen 20mph footpaths street lighting etc.
