I have been a proud resident of Trinity Ward for nearly a quarter of a century, my parents live in Painswick, so I know that these places are completely different Wards. The needs, priorities and problems of these areas are very different. Trinity Ward is a lively and active ward in a semi urban area, Bisley and Painswick are delightful rural villages that face different issues. It would be completely inappropriate to combine what is essential a small town district with two rural and well appointed villages.
