Related subject: Butterow, a village in Rodborough

While not appreciating the term , my understanding is that my village and that of Montserrat, Bagpath, Swellshill and Bownham, all of which are in the parish of Rodborough and which are currently represented by a Rodborough county councillor would potentially be represented by a county councillor based in Cranham or Bisley or Painswick. This seems daft. In your report you indicate the parish council's desire for all areas of Rodborough to be part of the same electoral division and that you'd honour this. I am confused. I really don't agree with this suggested boundary change. We are separated from Cranham, Bisley and Painswick by distance (8 to 14 km compared to 1.5km to Rodborough), the A419 and the mainline railway line which itself forms one of the Rodborough parish council's boundaries. None of the roads to these locations runs directly from here (all go via Stroud), most local employment is in Rodborough or Stroud and our school children almost all go to Rodborough, Gastrells, Amberley, Stroud Valleys or Minchinhampton primary schools. I really object to this proposed boundary change.
