Dear Sir or Madam,

With regard to your consultation on the proposed new electoral divisions for the county, I strongly object to the proposed changes affecting Trinity Ward in Stroud. To divorce this central ward from the rest of the town and join it with two rural parishes is not in the interests of residents. The services and facilities we residents use are primarily the ones in the town itself, not those in the villages. Residents of Trinity ward also have very different experiences and interests when it comes to transport and parking issues. Many residents chose to live in the ward specifically because it is in easy walking distance of the centre of town and train station etc. I do not feel that our interests would be properly represented by councillors who are largely serving a rural population.

Consequently I believe the proposal clearly contravenes the Council's own stipulations for good divisions in relation to Facilities, Transport and Community Interests. I sincerely hope that this plan is rethought and a more sensible solution found.
