I object strongly to the proposal to move Trinity Ward in with Bisley in this rearrangement of boundaries. My objection is primarily based on principles of community and belonging. Trinity people feel that they belong to Stroud. From my home in Middle Street (GL5 [REDACTED] postcode), I naturally gravitate down the hill into the centre of town, not north and east out into a rural parish. Several Stroud-wide services and amenities sit within Trinity: the hospital, the cemeteries, Trinity Rooms. The issues that affect Trinity are the same as those that concern Stroud Uplands and Stroud Valley – not Bisley. A county councillor under the proposed revisions might have no natural connection with Trinity. There would be a lack of cohesion with Town and District representation.
