**Related subject:** Proposed Stroud Central and Bisley & Painswick boundary changes

I have looked at the proposed Stroud Central and Bisley & Painswick boundary changes and am baffled by them. In particular, the proposed boundary line down Bisley Road, which suddenly removes Stroud General Hospital, Stroud Town Cemetary, Daisy Bank, the Graveyard and the surrounding residential streets from the Stroud Central ward. As the names suggest, these are definitely a part of Stroud Town itself and the idea that they should become a part of Bisley and Painswick is, quite frankly, ludicrous. I might add that the changes to the adjoining Minchinhampton boundary is just as inappropriate. They should definitely remain as they are, with Stroud Hospital and Cemetary remaining in the Stroud Town ward, especially with regards to the services and amenities. Bisley and Painswick are very different to Stroud town and the Trinity Ward, known as 'Old Stroud' are a part of the town, not the countryside.

None of the residents here that I have spoken to think it is a good idea, plus the Stroud Town Council unanimously opposed the proposal. Our wishes need to be heard.

I strongly object to these proposed boundary changes. This boundary should be kept as is.
