Related subject: Boundary changes for Oxshott

I wish to record my dissatisfaction with and objection to the latest proposal by LGBCE concerning boundary changes in the Oxshott area of Surrey because (a) it fails to reflect community identity and interests and (b) it will not be advantageous for, nor will it assist, the council to work affectively.

Oxshott must have a single identity without the proposed north/south divide which would split the community and should be placed entirely within a single division (as a two member division if necessary). Thus amenities such as medical facilities, schools, railway station, shops, roads and footpaths and the like can be encompassed within one division so as to maintain community identity, interests and cohesion. Areas either side of the A244 and to the north and south of Oxshott need to sit within only one division so that one councillor (or two) can be held accountable for the effective administration of the area as a whole.
