Supplementary points to initial deposition of my views.

1. It will be far less cumbersome for residents, and adult numbers will be pretty similar, if the roads Holtwood and Goldrings and Sheath lane (collectively known as Bevendean estate) which are to the S of the A244 are placed within the Cobham division and the weirdly annexed Danes Way estate to the NE of the A244 is left in the Esher division.

2. The black marker pen used along the A244 is very clumsy for a public document that residents are being asked to comment on. - Which side of the road does it run? Does it run down the middle? WHO WOULD HAVE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ROAD? From south of the railway bridge on Warren Lane, would the Esher councillor have responsibility for all housing fronting the East verge of the A244 AND the road and the Cobham one all houses fronting to the West? THIS NEEDS MUCH GREATER CLARITY PLEASE ; RESIDENTS ARE CONCERNED.

2. There is also a concern that the Cobham councillor could have both the A244 and the A245 under their care. It is possible the potential treatment required for these two roads might conflict yet the same councillor would be responsible for them and would find themselves in an invidious position. I would suggest therefore to avoid this potential conflict of interest that the actual A244 road, from A3 to Mole Valley boundary is under the total control of the Esher councillor.
