**Related subject:** North and South Jesmond Wards

Our preference is that North Jesmond and South Jesmond Wards remain unchanged as the two wards cover the community of Jesmond reasonably well. We are very concerned that you appear to be basing your assessment on the number of electors rather than the total population and that therefore Jesmond will be under represented due to the fact that it has a large population of young people.

We can understand that you may be looking to adjust Jesmond Ward boundaries based on the statistics you have provided that show a reduction in the number of electors in the wards. We are concerned that if you do this there will be an under representation of the population of these Wards. In accordance with the 2021 Census the population of North and South Jesmond Wards is less than the average of all Wards in the City but not to the extent of the numbers of electors that are used in the spreadsheet. It is likely that the reduction in the number of electors is due to the demographic make up of the population of the two wards where over 60% of the population is in the 10-29 year age range. Many of the people in this age range are transient with many of them being students. Other Wards in the City with similar demographics are Arthurs Hill, Monument and Ouseburn. In these Wards the number of electors are all less than 50% of the population. We believe that the populations as a whole should also be taken into consideration and that efforts should be made to increase the number of electors. It is likely that the Covid Pandemic has had an impact on the proportion of the population being registered to vote.

For many people the NE2 postcode describes the extent of Jesmond with the following exceptions:

- The NE2 1 Postcode Area includes Shieldfield which has its own community centre and is currently in the Ouseburn Ward.
- The NE2 3 Postcode Area includes the area to the north of Jesmond Dene Road known as High West Jesmond. The High West Jesmond

Residents Association describes the locality as a compact area of Newcastle upon Tyne nestled between Jesmond and Gosforth with close links to both neighbouring communities. This area is currently in Dene and South Gosforth Ward.

- The NE2 4 Postcode Area is to the west of the Town Moor. The residential part of this area is mostly in Spital Tongues that is currently in Wingrove Ward

The North and South Jesmond Wards have natural boundaries to the east and west, with Jesmond Dene to the east and the Town Moor to the west. The natural boundaries give a clear distinction between the communities on either side. The current northern boundary of North Jesmond Ward is formed by Jesmond Dene Road. Arguably there is a natural boundary to the north of High West Jesmond formed by the Crag Hall Burn which in this area is substantially in a culvert. The southern boundary is again substantially a natural boundary formed by Jesmond Dene, the City Stadium and the Central Motorway (A167(M)) with very short lengths of the boundary running along residential streets.

If changes are to be made to the Jesmond Ward boundaries then these should respect the boundaries of the community.

To assist I have added in the census data to your spreadsheet.
