Hi Sarah. I live on Greenhill and have just received information about the boundary changes that will lump my area with Redditch. I understand you are forwarding objections to the relevant parties and would like my views known.

Redditch councillors deal with a municipal area, whereas the area under discussion here is mostly residential and bordering on rural.
