The attached file shows the proposed split of Congleton into 3 wards of 2 councillors. This proposal was put forward as one of the final options during the Cheshire East Committee meetings but sadly did not make it through to the next stage, so I would like to re-propose this very sensible split. The current ballot box coded areas are as is, there is no change to this definition.

The 3 new wards have been referred to as Congleton West, Congleton Central and Congleton East.

Congleton West is 'West Heath' a defined area of Congleton, which includes Astbury Mere Country Park.

Congleton Central includes Lower Heath to the North and the central part of town, including the Bromley Farm Estate. CON3 is the small triangular ballot box code where the blue text 'Congleton' is shown. This area is of similar socioeconomic status.

Congleton East covers Buglawton (COB1 and COB2) and the rural areas of Congleton, please see maps in the attached spreadsheet.

The current situation of 2 wards in Congleton means that the areas are very large and difficult for councillors to manage. Having smaller areas means that councillors can focus on their communities in a more effective way. The proposed split is sensible - when the ballot box codes were first defined, areas of similar nature were assigned similar codes. All the COW, COC, CON, CNW, COS and COB wards have been kept together.



You can see that this is a sensible split of Congleton into 3 wards. When the ballot box nomenclature was first defined areas of similar nature were assigned similar codes. All the COW, COC, CON, CNW, COS and COB wards have been kept together.

Please excuse any red pen wobbles, the boundaries of the current town ballot box areas are as is for this proposal - there is no change required for the ballot box codes.

The numbers in red are unknown and estimates.
