I currently live in the Nantwich North and west ward but Cheshire east are proposing moving my polling district into the Nantwich South and Stapeley ward. but because of how the polling districts are arranged in Nantwich for the town council elections . I will be in the strange position of voting for town councillors in Nantwich North and Borough councillors in Nantwich South. . As the town council is already divided into 3 wards of I presume roughly equal size of about 4,500 it would seem logical that as town council elections and borough council elections are likely to take place of the same time that you vote in each of the three town council wards for one borough councillor. this would help maintain a strong link between local residents and the town and borough council. if also means that Stapeley ward which has it independent from Nantwich may need to join a smaller parish ward eg Willaston to meet sufficient voter numbers but given the recent plans for developing a further 200 houses there may be sufficient electors for Stapeley to have its own borough councillor
