Related subject: Dumbah Lane

[REDACTED] and myself live on Dumbah Lane at the Bollington end. Part of the Lane belongs to the Prestbury Ward whilst the other part belongs to the Bollington Ward, with the Tytherington/Bollington/Prestbury borders meeting in the field to the front of the houses on Dumbah Lane. Over the years these boundaries have caused confusion in various situations. One of which was when we intended to move house the estate agent marketed our property as “ Prestbury” as potential house purchasers potentially wouldn't view the property if it was marketed as Bollington, as their perception would be of a property quite some distance from where it actually is.

We have been made aware that there is a possibility that the Eastern end of Dumbah Lane could move from the Bollington Parish Ward to Macclesfield Parish Ward with the Bollington boundary ending at the Silk Road, and the Tytherington/Prestbury border still dividing Dumbah Lane and running across the field to the front of us. However, we have not been offered the option to go from the Bollington Parish to the Prestbury Parish, so that the entirety of the lane is in the same ward, which would be our preference.

Despite living in 'Bollington' our lives have revolved around Prestbury Village for the past 21 years through our children and our social and sporting lives as this is the area we actually feel we're closer to and have naturally connected with more. We socialise in Prestbury in The Rodney , The Legh Arms, Bacchus and The Coast. We walk our dog into Prestbury to meet friends at Henrys. Prestbury GC is a big part of our lives as was Prestbury CC over the years. Most of the residents on Dumbah Lane have far closer connections to Prestbury than they do to either Tytherington or Bollington. We would like you to consider moving the eastern border just 250 yards to Tytherington Lane to give the whole of Dumbah Lane the unity it deserves of being in one ward, and one which its residents have a great preference to be part of.

Dumbah Lane has a close knit community between the neighbours all with a common interest represented through the Dumbah Association. We are one small lane with confused boundaries and essentially it would make more sense for the whole of the lane to be classed under one ward boundary instead of 2 with the boundaries being The Silk Rd (between Prestbury and Bollington) and Tytherington Lane (between Prestbury and Tytherington).

We would be very grateful if you would take our preference into consideration.
