Related subject: Proposed Amendments to Ward Boundaries

Re: The Public Consultation on The Further Draft Recommendations for Ward Boundaries in Bradford

Wilsden Parish Council does not support the latest revised ward boundaries because it is our view that the villages of Bingley Rural have a different and separate community identity than the town of Bingley. We would therefore support a Bingley Rural Ward which was based on the boundaries of the first proposed division of ward boundaries. In other words, we would support a ward that consisted of the villages of Harden, Cullingworth, Wilsden and Cottingley.

We also have specific localized concerns should the proposed amendments go ahead in terms of the boundary between Wilsden and Cottingley. The existing polling district boundary between Wilsden and Cottingley follows the garden boundaries along parts of Lee Lane instead of the centre of the road. We have received strong representations from the residents of Lee Lane that should the new revisions be adopted, they would wish to be associated with Wilsden because that is the community which they have the closest identification with and they use the local services of Wilsden. We have illustrated the specific proposed boundaries on the attached document. The red line represents Wilsden Parish Council's proposed boundary. The blue line represents the existing boundary.

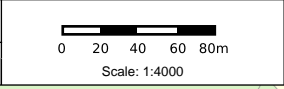
