April 2025


Currently there are:

- 90 councillors
- 88 single-councillor divisions and 1 two-councillor division

A public consultation is open until 9 June 2025

We are proposing:

- 89 councillors
- 85 single-councillor divisions and 2 two-councillor divisions



We aim to make sure North Yorkshire councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 49 divisions that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- 2 divisions that are more than 30% away from the average

Our proposals mean that:

- I division will be more than
 10% away from the average
 number of electors per division
- Each councillor will represent an average of 5,818 electors
