May I express my concern at the consideration for splitting Wychwood Village and Wychwood Park in Weston as part of the new plan.

Most in council/government won't be aware of the crucial link between them. They share the same original planning brief, share amenities including the hotel on the Park and village hall on the Village.

Not just that, but they share a combined Section 106 agreement protecting the site from further development. This Section 106 is iron-clad and previous used to defend against opportunist housing developers.
