We attend the Exmoor LCN meetings and are currently very involved in their Environmental, Housing and Highways strategies. We are exploring suitable locations for affordable housing with the Exmoor LCN 8 Parish Housing Group and are exploring waste water and flooding issues with Highways and Somerset River Authority. All these initiatives are under the auspices and advice of ENP.
