Comment text:

Please find below the response to the current phase of consultation for the Boundary Review for Somerset from the Conservative Group.

The Somerset Council Conservative Group participated in the All Party Working Group established by Somerset Council to prepare a division/ward structure to be proposed to the LGBCE in response to its call for submissions. The Conservative Councillors on the working group fed back issues raised by group members to the working group for discussion and consideration.

This involved considerable work by dedicated Council officers over many weeks and a number of cross party/officer meetings. It believes that the Working Group's recommended arrangement was sound overall and dealt overwhelmingly successfully with the complex challenges of achieving equality of numbers per seat, the desired total number of members, and the agreed preference for single-member divisions/wards.

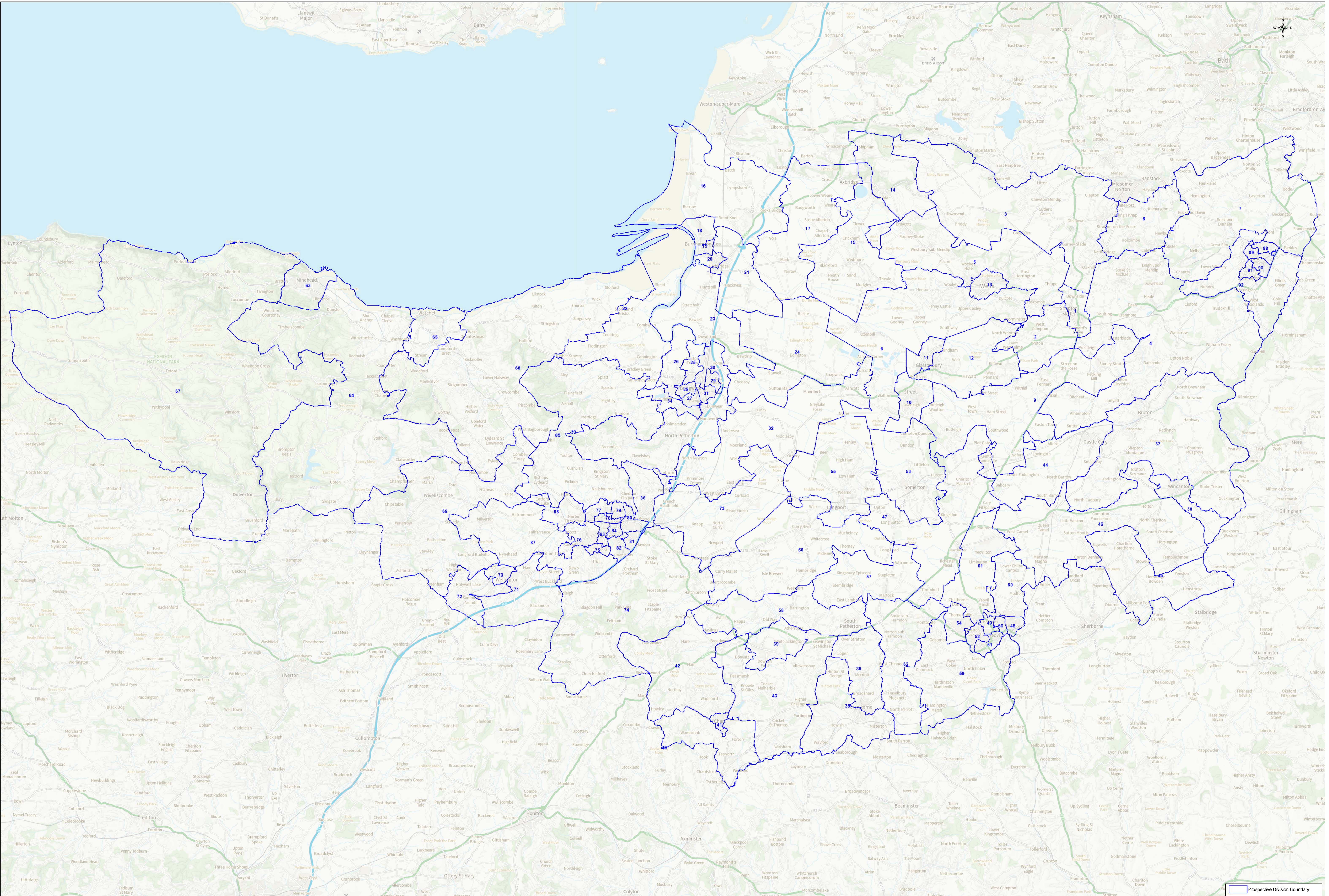
It recognises that the granular detail of the geographical composition of each seat is capable of adjustment. It is particularly conscious of concerns regarding, for example, Bridgwater and Ilminster Divisions (attached). It anticipates that the Boundary Commission will consider local representations and – should it accept the Working Group's proposals as a basis – make such changes as it deems appropriate, for further consultation.

The Somerset Council Conservative Group regrets that in the event the Council's Constitution and Governance Committee failed to endorse the Working Group's recommended structure, choosing instead not to make any submission to the LGBCE consultation.

Nevertheless, the considerable merit of the Working Group's proposals are such that the Conservative Group wishes to submit them formally to the LGBCE in the absence of a single Somerset Council view. (attached)

REPRESENTATION FROM COUNCILLOR DIOGO RODRIGUES – DIVISIONS 29 & 30

I am first giving some comments in disagreement with some of the proposals suggested by the Somerset Council Working Party – solely focused on **BRIDGWATER**. This will follow with suggested proposals that I would ask the LGBCE to consider alongside other comments they have received during the consultation process.

Disagreements

Division 29 – This proposal splits the Sydenham Estate into two different division. Sydenham Estate comprises of polling districts BAD and BAG. Everyone living in these two polling districts have historically identified themselves as living in Sydenham and have a strong sense of place, with local amenities supporting the community. The Sydenham Community Centre, located in BAG, is a testament to this and serves the entire estate. Also, with the current Somerset Council boundary, the Sydenham Estate is within one single division – this makes sense to the community.

Division 30 – This wraparound division does not make geographical sense, nor does it link with a sense of place or community. BAE and BAP1 have nothing in common with one another. Moreover, by 2030 the projected 1,000 plus increase in electorate numbers in BAP1 will be predominantly located on the land to the east of Bower Lane. These residents will have nothing relatable to those living in Bristol Rd or Polden St (in BAE). Residents in BAE and BAP1 use completely different shops, schools, play areas and other amenities.

My proposals would mean a bit of change for most of the Bridgwater proposed divisions, however I am focussing on just 3 divisions which relate to the above comments.

Proposals

Division 1 – To comprise of polling districts BAD, BAG and BAE. This ensures that the Sydenham Estate remains as one division due to the strong sense of place. It also incorporates electorate to the West of Sydenham, linking the electorate who live along Bath Road together rather than splitting them in two.

Division 2 – To comprise of polling districts BAH and BAC. These two polling districts are currently part of the existing Bridgwater East and Bawdrip division. They are quite independent and have amenities that serves each polling district well such as play areas, green spaces, shops etc.

Division 3 – To comprise of polling districts BAP1, BAP2, BAU & BAB. BAP1 & BAP2 are currently part of the existing Bridgwater East and Bawdrip division. They are also one Parish Council in itself. The parish council has just completed a community review with The Community Council for Somerset which will see it build even stronger ties to its electorate than it has already. Including BAU and BAB, in keeps the electorate together with its existing links as they form part of the existing unitary boundary.

REPRESENTATION FROM CLLR SUE OSBORNE FOR ILMINSTER AREA

In general, I support the Somerset Council All Party Working Group's proposal for the electoral arrangements across the whole of the Council area. However, I believe that there are concerns about the specifics in **the Ilminster area. I would like to outline those issues and then propose a different arrangement for the Ilminster seats and their names.**

* Ashill has been placed in **proposed division 58**, South Petherton and Ilton despite being separated from this grouping by the A358, one of the busiest main roads in the country which serves as a direct link from the A303 to the M5.

* Ashill works very closely with the other 3 parishes (Broadway, Horton and Donyatt) that are bounded on 2 sides by the A358 which also splits down to Chard and then down into East Devon linking with the A35 Dorset - Exeter arterial coast road.

* Ashill looks to Ilminster for its key services and utilises the Post Office/shop at Horton and the Doctors surgery at Broadway.

* Broadway (**proposed division 42**) and Horton (**proposed division 43**) should be kept together and not split into separate divisions as proposed

- The 2 parish councils work closely together, particularly on planning matters as development in one parish significantly impacts another.
- The parishes are not only contiguous but linked with one sitting on top of the other with the River Ding serving as the natural boundary.

* Key services are shared with each other.

- Horton provides a village shop and Post Office, plus a Methodist place of worship.
Broadway provides a school (Neroche) and a Doctors surgery.
- Neroche School takes pupils from Horton, Broadway, Donyatt and other surrounding Villages.
- Its catchment area was recently extended to take in part of Ilminster, possibly in anticipation of development at the Station Road/Canal Way end of Ilminster.
- The Doctors surgery caters for the rural parishes as well as Ilminster residents. It works closely with the Ilminster Surgeries.

* **Proposed Divisions 42 & 43** - The parishes of Kingstone, Dowlish Wake, Knowle St Giles, Chillington and Cudworth sit between the A30 and the boundary with Ilminster.

These parishes do work together and support each others fundraising events. They use facilities in Dowlish Wake such as the Pavillion and playing fields, Speke Hall, a farm Shop and pub.

Residents from Ilminster also use these facilities as well.

* Ilminster's Herne View primary school takes the children from the neighbouring villages.

Herne View in turn feeds into Wadham school in Crewkerne, so, there is no formal link as such to the secondary school (Holyrood) in Chard

*All the parishes along with Ilminster Town form half of the Crewkerne and Ilminster Local Community Network.

There are no links as such with Chard Town or its town Council wards.

* The 2 Chard Wards, Crimchard and Avishayes are wards of Chard Town Council and are urban in nature. They have virtually nothing in common with the Ilminster facing rural parishes that make up the current Ilminster Division.

The exceptions are Chaffcombe which Chard Reservoir falls into, particularly the critical dam wall side and it sluices and Winsham which looks to both Chard and Crewkerne and provides services to the tiny parish meeting of Cricket st Thomas.

* It should be noted that both the Chard wards make up 50% of the electorate which dominates the much smaller rural parishes. This risks the rural voice being weakened by dominant urban wards, and, their needs not being met and disregarded.

* Where possible, the parishes that fall between the A30 and the Ilminster town boundary should be kept together and the four parishes that are surrounded by the A358 should be grouped together and not split off into separate divisions.

* **Proposed Division 39** - Under the Somerset proposal, Ilminster's two polling districts were put together to make one division meaning that its surrounding parishes were severed from it.

Consideration should be given to creating two divisions for Ilminster so that links to its parishes can be retained and respect the inter-relationships between the parishes and the town.

These two newly created Ilminster divisions could be called Ilminster East and Ilminster West or Ilminster North and Ilminster South.

* Finally, the names for the proposed Somerset divisions,

42 - Chard North and division 43 - Chard East should be amended to reflect the rural nature of their constituent parishes. So:-

Divisions 42 should become Chard North Rural

Division 43 should become Ilminster Rural & Chard East or Ilminster and Chard Rural.

REPRESENTATION FROM CLLR BARRY CLARKE RE NUNNEY

Nunney being rural being placed with urban Frome is not ideal. Please could this be looked at as part of the review.

A common boundary does not confer any commonality on the residents or their aspirations. They each have their own identity. It is yet another artificial boundary that we have to work within with no consideration of anything other than numbers of voters. I counted once something like 12 or 13 boundaries that we find ourselves working within eg Fire, Police, NHS, highways etc.

The new area will still have a lot of parishes and to reduce everybody, apart from 3, to a single member ward, is a simplification. For densely populated areas that's fine. We do not do highly populated in the north of Somerset and our parishes are many and a long way apart. Some of mine are a half hour's drive away.
